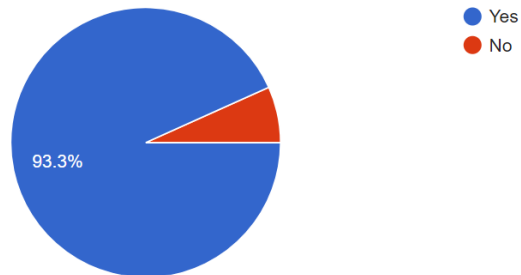


North College Park Community Center Survey Responses

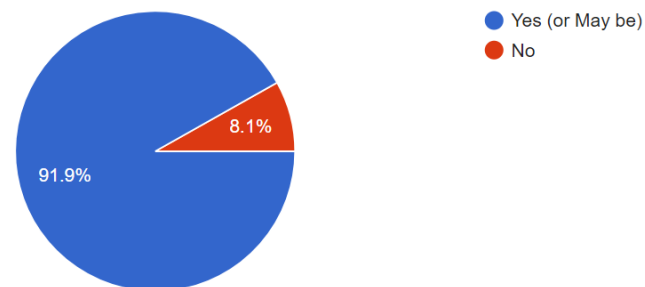
Do you support a community center in north College Park?

134 responses



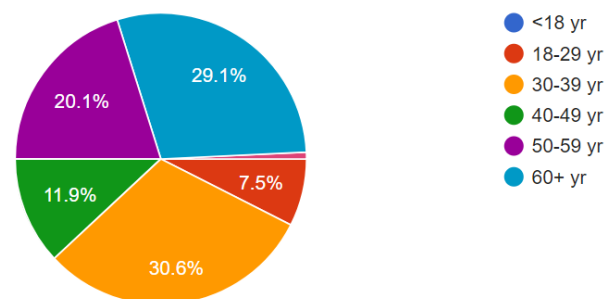
Will you make use of a community center in north College Park?

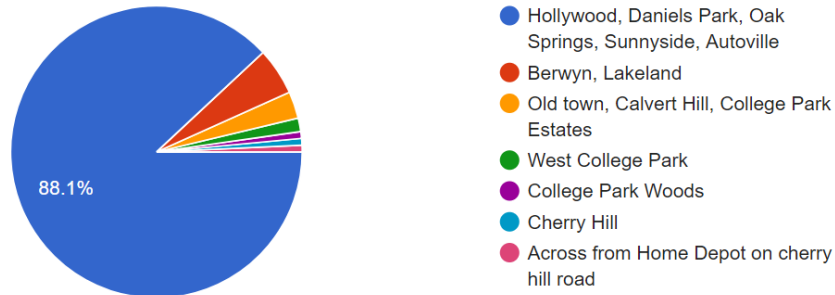
How old are you?

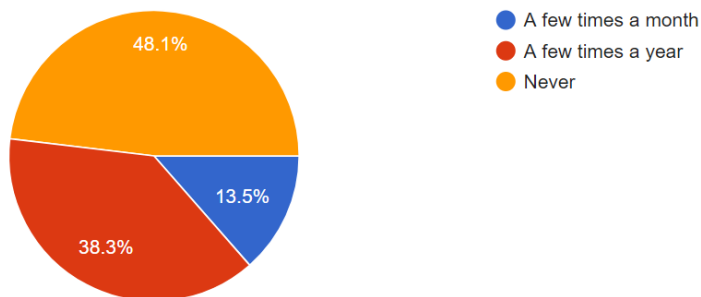
Where do you live?

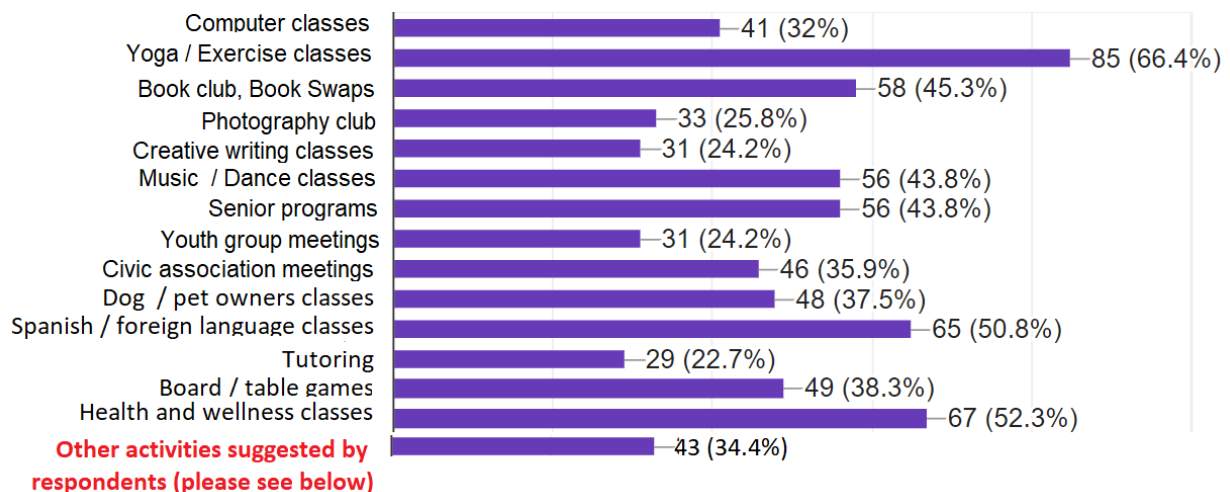


- Nothing available for kids under 3
