Dear Mayor and Council:

The North College Park Citizens Association, at its January 8, 2009, meeting, heard a presentation on the County's Master Plan of Transportation and took a position on two elements of the Plan, which we asked to be removed from the Plan:

- C-118, widening Rhode Island Ave. to four lanes; and
- P-200 extending Autoville Rd. North from Cherry Hill Rd. to Baltimore Ave. at Hollywood Rd.

Residents of the Hollywood and Autoville neighborhoods have long opposed widening/extending these roads. We ask that the City Council support its residents by taking a formal position requesting the widening of Rhode Island Avenue and the extension of Autoville Drive be removed from the County's Master Plan of Transportation.
