The North College Park Community Association would like to bring to your attention the bollards located on Cherry Hill Road just west of Route 1. The bollards, which were placed at the location about a decade ago, were the direct result of a request by residents in the Cherry Hill and North Autoville neighborhoods and supported by then County Councilperson Mary Lehman.

Until about three years ago, the bollards had been effective in keeping vehicles from making left hand turns from the College Park Marketplace onto Cherry Hill Rd. which was the initial purpose. Over the years, however, they have become a safety hazard, as well as an eyesore as they are knocked down and dragged down the street. Furthermore, they no longer serve their purpose because the majority of them are missing.

As North College Park residents who drive this road on a daily basis, we would appreciate your agency replacing and restoring the bollards this summer. Thank you for your time and consideration.
